MP Sara Olsvig finished her Masters Degree in Anthropology (Cand.Scient.Anth.) from the University of Copenhagen in 2008. Between 2009-2011, Sara Olsvig worked at the Inuit Circumpolar Council (ICC) as Coordinator of Human Rights Issues, and later as Executive Director.

At the general election for the Danish Parliament in September 2011, Sara Olsvig was listed for the political party Inuit Ataqatigiit and was elected with 35.5% of the total Greenlandic votes.

Currently, Sara Olsvig holds the following positions in Committees at the Danish Parliament:
Chairwoman of the Committee on Conditions in Greenland, as well as a Member of the
Environment Committee, the Defense Committee and the Foreign Policy Committee. Sara is also
Deputy Member of the Nordic Council, and is the Danish Parliament's representative of the
Standing Committee of Parliamentarians of the Arctic Region (SCPAR).

Sara Olsvig was elected member of the Greenlandic parliament at the general election in March 2013.
